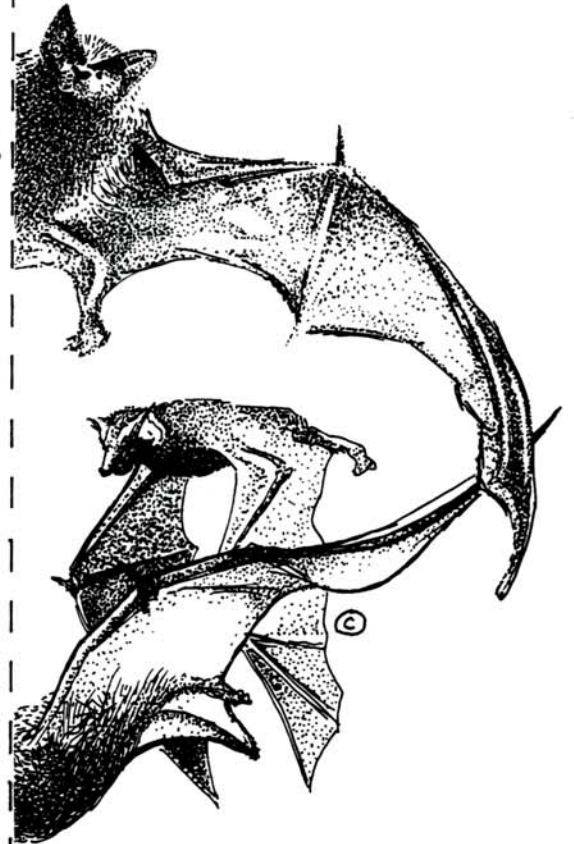

BATS ...

Are the only mammals that fly. Their wings consist of a double membrane thinly stretched across enlarged arm bones and greatly elongated fingers. Most bats have small eyes and poor vision and use echolocation to navigate and locate prey. Nearly all North American species are insectivorous; in winter, when few insects are available, most hibernate hanging upside down, often in vast numbers. Some migrate to warmer climates.
